Trinity Catholic Academy will be celebrating National Catholic Schools Week from January 31st through February 6th. Catholic Schools Week celebrations have become a tradition since its beginning in 1974. As you know, it is important to recognize the role that Catholic schools play in providing an education that emphasizes not only academics, but also spiritual, moral, and social values to over 2.5 million students in the United States.

This year "Walking in the Footsteps of Jesus" will be our theme.
